Each subsequent dose also requires approval. Provider must purchase seed doses. Quarterly replacement dose shipments. GSK	<p>Hepatitis A (Havrix®)</p> <p>Hepatitis B (Engerix-B®)</p> <p>Hepatitis A & B combo (Twinrix®)</p> <p>Human Papilloma Virus (Cervarix®)</p> <p>Tdap (Boostrix®)</p>	<p>19 years or older. 19-25 years old female (Cervarix).</p> <p>No third party vaccine coverage.</p> <p>Annual household income less than: -- \$\$27,225 for individuals -- \$36,77 for couples or -- \$55,87 for a family of four.</p> <p>U.S. resident (patient does not have to be a citizen).</p> <p>To expedite patient enrollment, ask patient to bring proof of income to their appointment.</p>	<p>Each prescribing clinician registers with program online prior to enrolling patients. Provider registration number required on patient registration form.</p> <p>Tip: Pre-enter provider numbers on patient eligibility forms.</p>	<p>GSK approves eligibility for each patient before vaccine is administered--response guaranteed within 10 minutes. Patients eligibility lasts for one-year (and can be renewed). Each subsequent dose also requires approval. Monthly replacement dose shipments. Replenishment is exact dose for dose given through the program.
